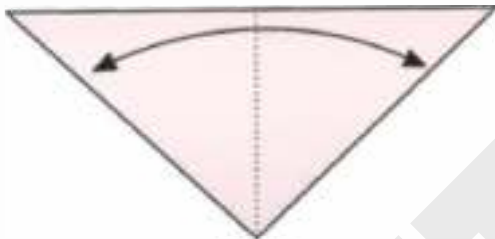
# Paper Folding

Follow the steps to make an origami LADYBUG.

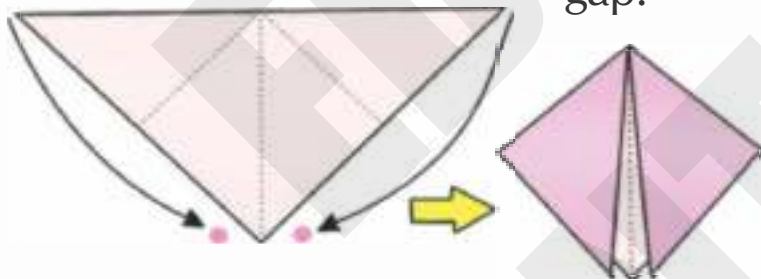
**1** Start with a square piece of paper, white side up. Fold in half.



**2** Fold this triangle in half, crease well then open.



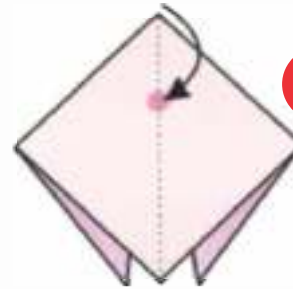
**3** Fold the top 2 corners downwards, but not right to the center line: leave a little gap.

**6** Turn back over. Finished Ladybug.



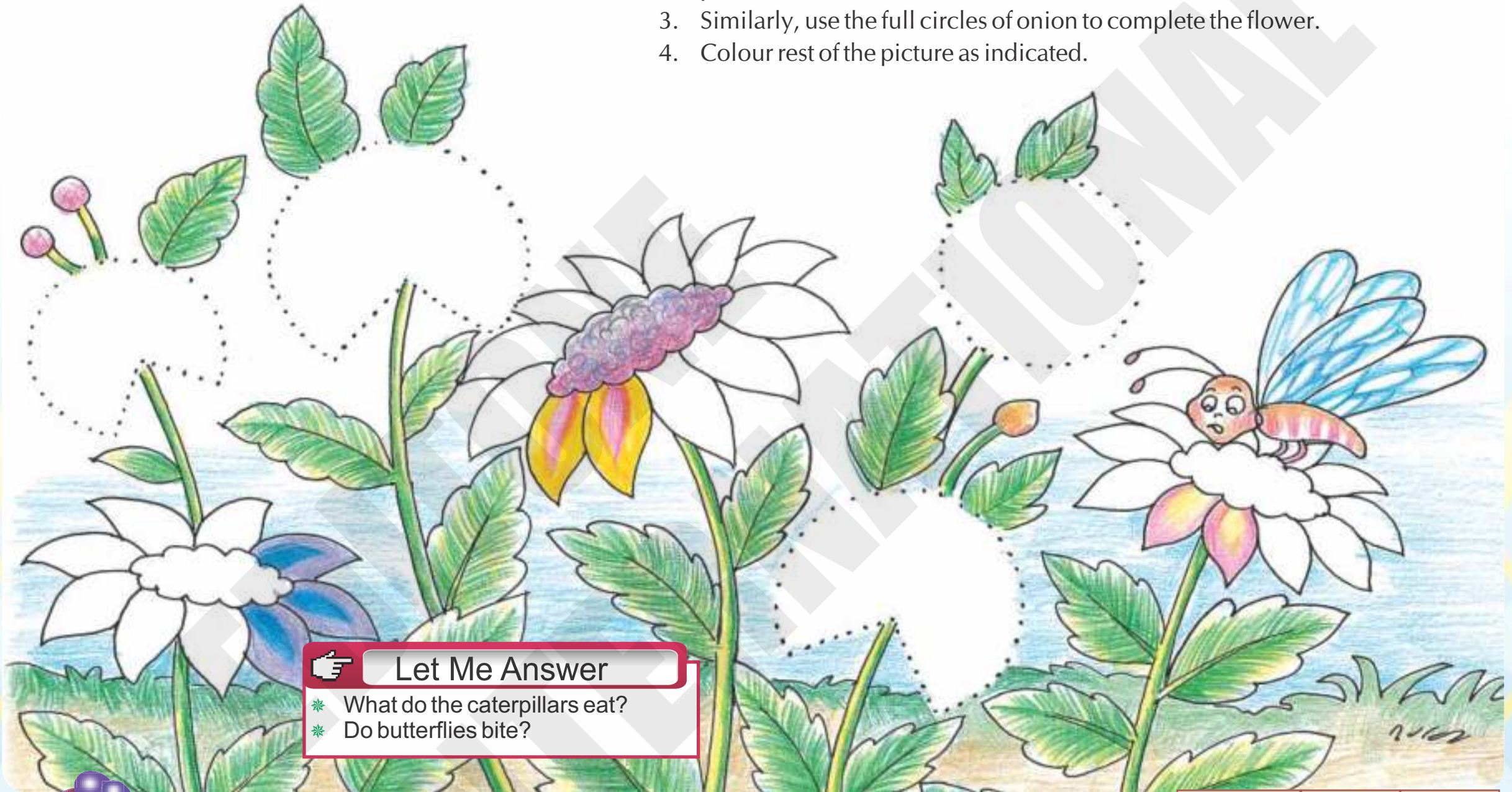

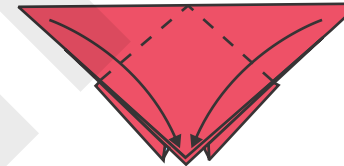
Flatten the model. This is called water bomb base.
