Some Pencil Shading Techniques

Some important pencil shading techniques are mentioned here.

FACT FILE

The current record holder for biggest pencil in the world is in Malaysia.

Repetition: By repeating our pencil strokes, we may get different types of patterns and textures. We divide this technique into three parts: (i) Etching, (ii) Cross etching and (iii) scribbling.

Etching:

Light etching

Dark etching

Darker etching

Small short strokes may be slanted, usually drawn in a downward direction. We may add more pressure and more repetition to get a dark shade.

Cross etching:

Cross etching is done by shading lines in such a way that all lines cross each other to create a darker shade and desired effect.

Scribbling:

Light scribbling

Medium scribbling

Dark scribbling

Scribbling is done by using the pressure on the pencil. We may give more pressure and repeat scribbling to get darker type of scribbling.



A piece of cotton cloth or a piece of cotton is used for smudging. It makes our work much easier, less time consuming while shading big sketches and making even shading effects.






Perspective Drawing

The art of drawing solid objects on a two dimensional surface so as to give the right impression of relative position, size etc. from a particular distance as they appear to viewer's eye level is called 'Perspective Drawing'. Due to perspective, objects look bigger at front and appear to be small as they move away and seems to vanish at the point called vanishing point.









Hair Style and Features


Drawing Animals (Template Technique)




- 2. Chart paper of yellow colour
- 4. Poster Colours


Steps to follow:
