





Advice pupils to use clean objects in their daily life.



Wash your face with soap and water. Then dry it with a clean towel.



Clean your ears with soft cotton buds.



Wash your hair regularly and comb them neatly.



Trim your nails regularly.



Do not rub your eyes. Always wash your eyes with cold water.



Use a handkerchief while wiping the nose.



Wash your hands before and after eating.



Never walk outside with bare feet.

Walking, running, skipping, cycling and playing are very good exercises.







All the children go to school. They learn to read and write in the school. They learn good habits too. Many people work in a school like principal, teacher, guard, driver, sweeper, etc.








### Gurpurab

### 1. Independence Day


Independence Day is celebrated on 15th August every year. On this day, our country became independent from the British rule. Prime Minister of our country hoists the National Flag on this day.
