

















Materials Required:









Paper Folding

Follow the steps to make an origami LADYBUG.




Start with a square piece of paper, white side up. Fold in half.




Turn model over. Fold down top corner to the center point of the model.

Turn back over. Finished Ladybug.



Steps:


- 1. Cut a large hole in the paper plate.

- 4. Optional: Decorate the hearts with the names of the children. Also glitter is a nice touch.













Landscape

YARN WRAPPED CARDINAL

Let Me Answer

Follow the steps given below and make a yarn wrapper bird with the material provided.

Use the pattern to trace and cut out the body for your blue jay.

You also need to cut out a beak and legs from your cardboard. Paint the bird's body blue, beak and legs black.

Wrap the blue Jay bird's body with the blue yarn. Tape the end on the back of the bird's body.



Heat up your hot glue gun. Glue a small blue feather at the top of the head and a larger bird feather on the side of the bird for the wing. Next glue your white felt pieces onto your bird. Lastly glue your beak, legs and googly eye onto your blue Jay. At the neck area wrapa black yarn.

Cut out a piece of white felt to use it for the bird's belly and one for the face. We'ill make the face similar to our cardinal craft. The belly is just half of an oval.







If you wish you can create figures with your own imagination. Take a colour palette fill it with different water colours. Dip your thumb in it and put thumb impressions on different places using different colours.






Make the rainbow by following the steps given on this page. Colour the clouds with pencil colours.

Note: Let the painting dry up for sometime.












Make creases as shown.

Flatten the model. This is called water bomb base.




Fold the left and the right sides upwards to the upper and turn over the model.




e left and the right sides

Fold the left and the right sides down to the centre line.






Again fold the upper flaps from the dotted line as given.

It is completed.












Follow the instructions given below to make a brinjal with toothbrush painting.
