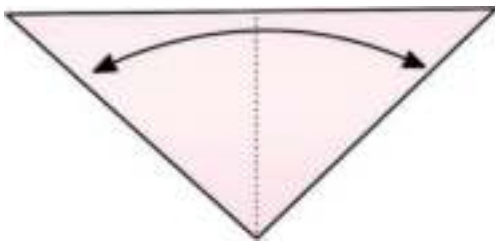


Paper Folding

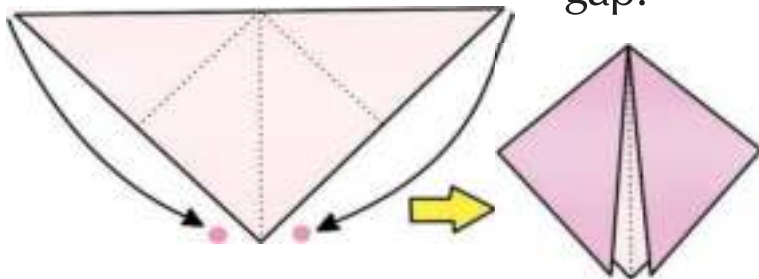
Follow the steps to make an origami LADYBUG.



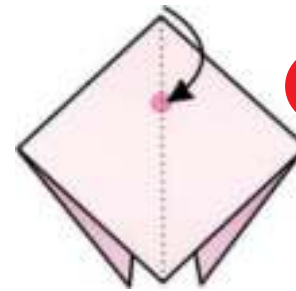
1 Start with a square piece of paper, white side up. Fold in half.



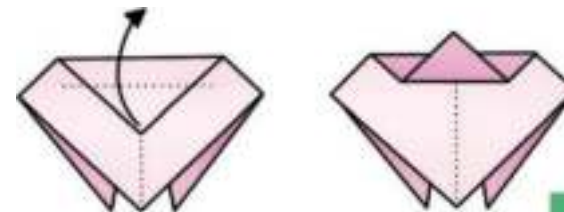
2 Fold this triangle in half, crease well then open.



3 Fold the top 2 corners downwards, but not right to the center line: leave a little gap.



4 Turn model over. Fold down top corner to the center point of the model.



5 Now fold this corner upwards, and flatten.

6 Turn back over. Finished Ladybug.

5. Optional-glitter

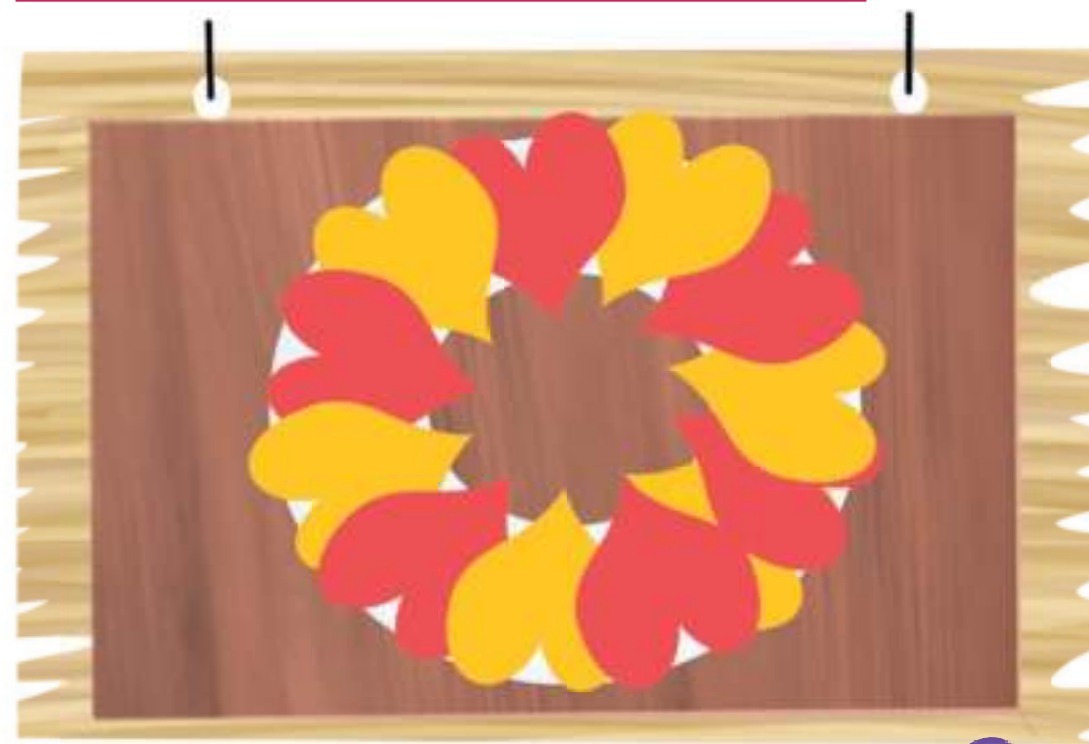
Steps:

- 4 No area should be left without rice on it.

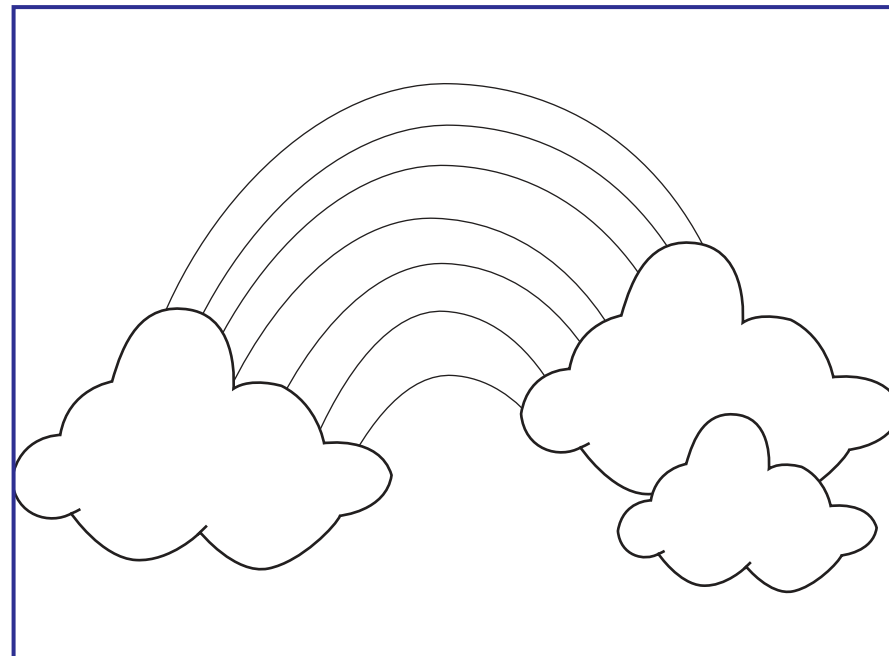
