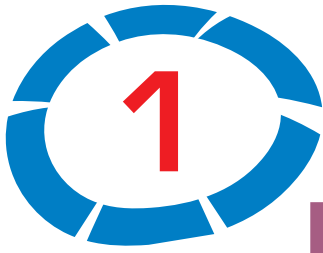

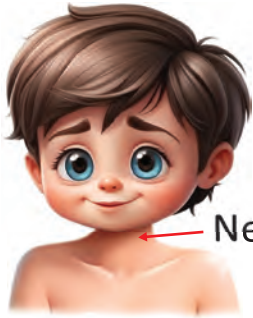

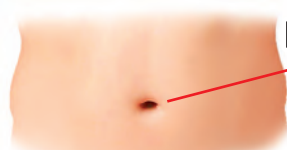

DAYS

There are 7 days in a week.
We call the previous day **YESTERDAY**.
We call the present day **TODAY**.
We call the next day **TOMORROW**.

Sunday	(रविवार)	is the 1st day of the week.
Monday	(सोमवार)	is the 2nd day of the week.
Tuesday	(मंगलवार)	is the 3rd day of the week.
Wednesday	(बुधवार)	is the 4th day of the week.
Thursday	(गुरुवार)	is the 5th day of the week.
Friday	(शुक्रवार)	is the 6th day of the week.
Saturday	(शनिवार)	is the 7th day of the week.

MONTHS

There are 12 months in a year.

January 31	February 28/29	March 31	April 30
May 31	June 30	July 31	August 31
September 30	October 31	November 30	December 31

Keep in Mind

The month of february has 29 days in a leap year. How to find a leap year?

1. A year whose 4 number is divisible by 4 is a leap year. Example: 1960,1964,1996,2008,2012 etc.
2. If the year ends in 00 (e.g., 2000), it is necessary to divide by 400. If there is no remainder, so it is a leap year.

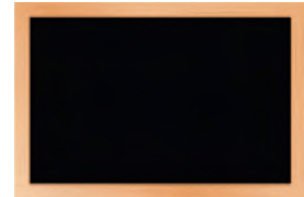
